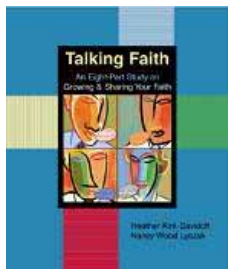

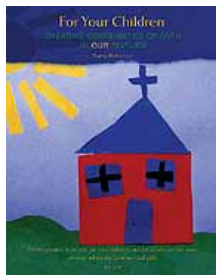

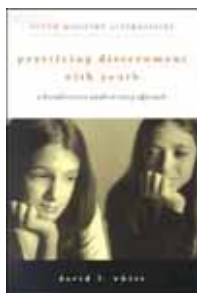
Talking Faith. Heather Kirk Davidoff, Nancy Wood-Lyczak. Chalice Press.

This resource emphasizes that faith is nurtured through Conversation with God (prayer) and conversation with Others (evangelism) particularly with persons who Are not part of a faith community.



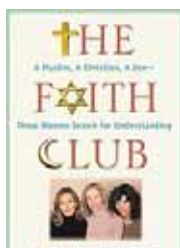
For Your Children: Creating Communities of Faith in Our Families. Martha Bettis Gee. Presbyterian Peacemaking.
