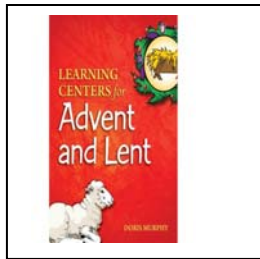

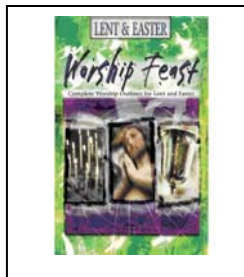

Doris Murphy. Twenty Third Publications. 2008

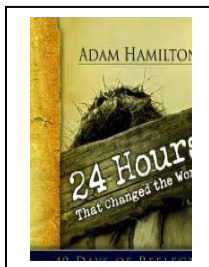
